invite your club to participate in the 14<sup>th</sup> Wynton Rufer Tournament**

**Participation:** 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> Grades inclusively (Normal Capital Football Age Regulations apply).

**Cost:** 7 & 8 grade \$60 per team  
9 & 10 grade \$65 per team

**Venue:** Stop Out Grounds - [Hutt Park, Moera \(Wellington\)](#)

**Format:** **7 & 8 Grade:** Each team will play a minimum of 5 x 20 minute games in Round Robin pools. Winners of each pool will then move into semis and final.

**9 & 10 Grade:** Each team will play a minimum of 4 x 25 minute games in Round Robin. Teams will then enter into play-off structure (Cup, Plate and Shield).

The actual structure will depend on entries received.

<b>Sunday 8 August</b>	7 and 8 Grades	Team of 6 players. Rolling Subs allowed
<b>Sunday 15 August</b>	9 and 10 Grades	Teams of 7 players. Rolling Subs allowed

### **Reserve Day—29 August**

Clubs are initially limited to one team per grade. However, once initial entries are received, we always open it up to extras, from the larger clubs. To simplify this process, can clubs who seek more than one entry per grade, send an entry form for their extra teams (no payment required at this stage) and we will randomly select these.

For those who are new to the Tournament, refreshments are available on site.

In the past entries were received from as far away as Wanganui, and we hope to expand our reach even further this year.

This is a great opportunity to enjoy the beautiful game, meet new people and play against teams you wouldn't normally get to play.
